SAO, et al., 15 Defendants. 16 Plaintiff Louis Perez ("Plaintiff") is a California state prisoner proceeding pro se and in 17 forma pauperis in this civil action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. Plaintiff filed this action on 18 September 22, 2014. He names J. Sao, M.D., K. C. Lo, M.D., and D. Beregovskaya, M.D., as 19 20 Defendants. 21 On July 17, 2015, the Court screened the complaint and issued an order dismissing the 22 complaint with leave to file an amended complaint. Plaintiff was granted thirty (30) days to comply. 23 Over thirty days have passed and Plaintiff has failed to file an amended complaint or otherwise 24 communicate with the Court. 25 Accordingly, Plaintiff is ORDERED TO SHOW CAUSE why this action should not be 26 dismissed for failure to state a claim. Plaintiff shall file a response to this order within fourteen (14) 27 days of the date of service. 28
