ORDER (1) GRANTING PLAINTIFFS' MOTION FOR STATUS (ECF NO. 12) AND (2) FORWARDING SERVICE DOCUMENTS TO PLAINTIFFS FOR COMPLETION

Plaintiffs are proceeding *pro se* and *in forma pauperis* in this action brought pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983.

Before the Court is Plaintiffs' request for status and clarification. (ECF No. 12.) Plaintiffs seek a status on Plaintiff Charlene Boeh's *in forma pauperis* application and service on Defendants.

On May 15, 2015, the Court granted Plaintiff Boeh's *in forma pauperis* application. The Court finds that service of the Complaint is appropriate.

Accordingly, it is HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. Plaintiff's motion for a status is GRANTED;
2. The Clerk of the Court shall send Plaintiffs four (4) USM-285 forms, four (4) summonses, a Notice of Submission of Documents form, an instruction

1 sheet, and a copy of the Complaint (ECF No. 1) filed September 23, 2014;

2 3. Within thirty (30) days from the date of this order, Plaintiffs shall complete

3 the attached Notice of Submission of Documents and submit the

4 completed Notice to the Court with the following documents:

5 a. Completed summons;

6 b. One completed USM-285 form for each Defendant; and

7 c. Five (5) copies of the endorsed Complaint filed September 23, 2014;

8 4. Plaintiffs need not attempt service on Defendants and need not request

9 waiver of service. Upon receipt of the above-described documents, the

10 Court will direct the United States Marshal to serve the Defendants

11 pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 4 without payment of costs.
