Petitioner, a state prisoner proceeding *pro se*, filed a petition for writ of habeas corpus under 28 U.S.C. § 2254 on October 14, 2014. The Court dismissed the petition as successive on December 12, 2014. 28 U.S.C. § 2244(b).

Petitioner has filed several motions including a motion for DNA testing, a motion to vacate his sentence, and a motion for return of restitution funds. (See ECF Nos. 11, 14-15.)
