County Superior Court, where it was originally filed as *Mission Bank v. Robert L. Corsaro, et al.*, Case  
No. S-1500-CV-282184 DRL.

The parties shall bear their own court costs and attorney's fees.

The Clerk of the Court shall forward a copy of this Order to the Clerk of the Kern County  
Superior Court.
