21	pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(a)(1)(A)(i).	
22	In relevant part, Rule 41(a)(1)(A) provides as follows:	
23	[A] plaintiff may dismiss an action with a court order by filing: (i) a notice of dismissal before the opposing party serves either an answer or a motion for summary judgment; or (ii) a stipulation of dismissal signed by all parties who	
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25	have appeared.	
26	Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(a)(1)(A). "The plaintiff may dismiss some or all of the defendants, or some	
27 28	or all of his claims, through a Rule 41(a)(1) notice," and the dismissal "automatically	
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1	terminates the action as to the defendants who are the subjects of the notice." Wilson v. City of	
2	San Jose, 111 F.3d 688, 692 (9th Cir. 1997).	
3	Because Plaintiff filed a notice of dismissal of this case with prejudice under Rule	
4	41(a)(1)(A)(i), this case has automatically terminated. Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(a)(1)(A)(i).	
5	Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court is to	
6	administratively close this case.
