Plaintiff F.L. Odinson Crowell, a state prisoner, originally filed this civil action through counsel on November 3, 2014. The action was administratively designated as a regular civil action. On January 5, 2014, Defendant filed an answer to the complaint.

On February 13, 2105, the Court granted Plaintiff's substitution of attorney and Plaintiff now proceeds pro se. The Court has reviewed the complaint and determined that the present action involves a pro se prisoner litigating the conditions of his prison confinement.

Accordingly, it is **HEREBY ORDERED** as follows:

1. The Clerk of the Court **SHALL** change the administrative designation of the present case to reflect that of a pro se prisoner litigating the conditions of his prison
