17	Plaintiff William Birdsall is a state prisoner proceeding pro se and in forma pauperis in	
18	this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. This action proceeds on plaintiff's second	
19	amended complaint (Doc. No. 17) asserting a due process violation claim against defendant	
20	James.	
21	Defendant James filed a motion to dismiss on October 2, 2017. (Doc. No. 23.) On	
22	August 10, 2018, the assigned magistrate judge issued findings and recommendations	
23	recommending denial of defendant James' motion to dismiss. (Doc. No. 44.) The findings and	
24	recommendations were served on the parties and contained notice that any objections thereto	
25	were required to be filed within fourteen days after service. ( <i>Id.</i> at 7–8.) More than fourteen days	
26	have passed, and no objections have been filed.	
27	In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C), this court has conducted a	
28	de novo review of this case and carefully reviewed the entire file. The court finds that the

1	findings and recommendations are supported by the record and by proper analysis.	
2	Accordingly,	
3	1. The findings and recommendations issued on August 10, 2018 (Doc. No. 44) are	
4	adopted in full;	
5	2. Defendant James' motion to dismiss (Doc. No. 23) is denied; and	
6	3. This matter is referred back to the assigned magistrate judge for further proceedings	
7	consistent with this order.
