(Document 11) 14 GOMEZ, et al., 15 Defendants. 16 Plaintiff Guillermo Trujillo ("Plaintiff") is a California state prisoner proceeding pro se in 17 this civil action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. Plaintiff filed this action on November 17, 2014. The 18 complaint is awaiting screening. 19 20 On December 8, 2014, Plaintiff filed a motion to file a "supplemental" complaint pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 15(a). On December 19, 2014, the Court issued an order explaining 21 that Plaintiff did not need leave to file an amended complaint at this stage of the proceedings. The 22 Court also provided Plaintiff with the requirements for amending. 23 On December 22, 2014, Plaintiff filed another motion to file a supplemental complaint. On 24 December 23, 2014, the Court disregarded Plaintiff's motion. The Court informed Plaintiff that 25 could file an amended complaint, as explained by the prior order. The Court also explained to 26 Plaintiff that to the extent he wanted to add the allegations in the motion, he could not do so. 27

On December 18, 2014, Plaintiff filed a "motion for exhibits." He attaches two exhibits that appear to relate to his original allegations. Plaintiff's motion is DISREGARDED and the Clerk of Court is instructed to return the documents to Plaintiff. At this time, it is unclear whether Plaintiff will be filing an amended complaint, and the Court will not docket exhibits. Plaintiff may file the exhibits with an amended complaint.
