On January 23, 2015, Plaintiff filed multiple requests 17 seeking an outside investigator to help investigate the alleged violations of rules and policies by 18 Coalinga State Hospital. (ECF Nos. 10, 14.) 19 20 The expenditure of public funds on behalf of an indigent litigant is proper only when authorized by Congress. See Tedder v. Odel, 890 F.2d 210 (9th Cir.1989) (citations omitted). The 21 in forma pauperis statute does not authorize the expenditure of public funds for the purpose 22 sought by Plaintiff in the instant requests. Accordingly, Plaintiff's motions for the appointment 23 of an outside investigator are HEREBY DENIED. 24 IT IS SO ORDERED. 25 26 /s/ Barbara A.
