17 On November 18, 2014, Plaintiff filed this Civil Rights Complaint pursuant to 42 U.S.C §  
18 1983 challenging Defendants' assessment, classification and detention of Plaintiff under California's  
19 Sexually Violent Predator Act and failure to provide him outpatient treatment in violation of the  
20 Fourteenth Amendment to the United States Constitution. (ECF No. 1.)

21 A number of virtually identical actions have been filed in or transferred to this Court. The  
22 Court's review of these cases reveals that the instant action is related under Local Rule 123 to the  
23 action entitled Klein v. King, 1:14-cv-01440-MJS. Both actions are based on the same underlying  
24 facts and involve overlapping questions of law and fact.

25 Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- 26 1. The Office of the Clerk shall relate this case with 1:14-cv-01440-MJS;  
27 2. The Case shall be assigned to the docket of District Judge Lawrence J. O'Neill and  
28 reassigned to the docket of Magistrate Judge Michael J. Seng;
