For the Court to grant Plaintiff's motion, the application 14 15 must be amended and re-submitted with a completed caption, inclusion of Plaintiff's name within the 16 declaration, and inclusion of the date of signature. 17 Accordingly, the Court DENIES Plaintiffs' motion to proceed in forma pauperis without 18 prejudice and GRANTS Plaintiff leave to submit an amended declaration.
