ORDER RELATING CASES AND
REASSIGNING ACTION TO DISTRICT
JUDGE LAWRENCE J. O'NEILL AND
MAGISTRATE JUDGE MICHAEL J. SENG

On November 18, 2014, Plaintiff Dennis Mack, a civil detainee proceeding pro se, filed this Civil Rights Complaint pursuant to 42 U.S.C. section 1983 challenging Defendants' assessment, classification and detention of Plaintiff under California's Sexually Violent Predator Act and failure to provide him outpatient treatment in violation of the Fourteenth Amendment of the U.S. Constitution. (ECF No. 1.)

A number of virtually identical actions have been filed in or transferred to this Court. The Court's review of these cases reveals that the instant action is related under Local Rule 123 to the action entitled *Klein v. King*, 1:14-cv-01440-MJS. Both actions are based on the same underlying facts and involve overlapping questions of law and fact.

Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. The Office of the Clerk shall relate this case with case 1:14-cv-01440-MJS;
