21	Reform Act. Page v. Torrey, 201 F.3d 1136, 1140 (9th Cir. 2000).	
22	On January 23, 2015, Plaintiff filed the Complaint commencing this action, together with an application to proceed in forma pauperis pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915. However, the

24	application to proceed in forma pauperis was submitted on the form for a prisoner. Plaintiff shall	
25	be allowed time to submit an application on the appropriate form for a non-prisoner.
