(Docs. 1, 3.) On July 2, 2015, The Court denied 18 19 Plaintiff's application because he has suffered "three strikes" under the Prison Litigation Reform 20 Act and could not demonstrate he was in imminent danger of serious physical harm. 28 U.S.C. § 21 1915(g). Thus, the Court ordered him to pay the \$400.00 filing fee within thirty days. (Docs. 22 14.) More than thirty days have passed and Plaintiff has failed to pay the filing fee or otherwise 23 respond. 24 A civil action may not proceed absent the submission of either the filing fee or a completed application to proceed in forma pauperis. 28 U.S.C. §§ 1914, 1915. Based on 25 26 Plaintiff's ineligibility to proceed in forma pauperis and his failure to comply with the Court's 27 order to pay the filing fee in full, dismissal of this action is appropriate. *In re*

Local Rule 110. Accordingly, it is HEREBY RECOMMENDED that this action be DISMISSED without prejudice for Plaintiff's failure to pay the \$400.00 filing fee. These Findings and Recommendations will be submitted to the United States District Judge assigned to the case, pursuant to the provisions of Title 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(l). Within 30 days after being served with these Findings and Recommendations, Plaintiff may file written objections with the Court. The document should be captioned "Objections to Magistrate Judge's Findings and Recommendations." Plaintiff is advised that failure to file objections within the specified time may result in the waiver of rights on appeal. Wilkerson v. Wheeler, 772 F.3d 834, 839 (9th Cir. 2014) (citing *Baxter v.
