Plaintiff, a prisoner proceeding pro se, filed this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. on February 6, 2015. Plaintiff filed a motion seeking leave to proceed in forma pauperis, the form application he submitted lacks the requisite authorization for the deduction of the fee from Plaintiff's trust account as funds are available. 28 U.S.C. § 1915.

Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

23 1. Within **forty-five (45) days** from the date of service of this order, Plaintiff shall
24 file the attached application to proceed in forma pauperis, completed and signed, or in the
25 alternative, pay the \$350.00 filing fee for this action;

2. No extension of time will be granted without a showing of good cause; and
