Pursuant to the stipulation, Plaintiff's opening brief was due on November 4, 2015; and 14 all other dates in the Court's scheduling order were to be amended accordingly. (ECF No. 17.) 15 Plaintiff filed her opening brief on November 2, 2015. (ECF No. 18.) Pursuant to the 16 February 12, 2015 scheduling order, Defendant's responsive brief was due within thirty days. 17 (ECF No. 6.)
