23	[A] plaintiff may dismiss an action with a court order by filing: (i) a notice of dismissal before the opposing party serves either an answer or a motion for summary judgment; or (ii) a stipulation of dismissal signed by all parties who

26	Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(a)(1)(A). "The plaintiff may dismiss some or all of the defendants, or some		e
27	or all of his claims, through a Rule 41(a)(1) notice," and the dismissal "automatically		У
28	terminates the action as to the defendants who are the subjects of the notice." Wilson v. City of		

San Jose, 111 F.3d 688, 692 (9th Cir. 1997). Because Plaintiff filed a notice of dismissal of before an answer or motion for summary judgment was filed by Defendants, this case has terminated.
