On October 20, 2015, the parties filed a stipulation of dismissal, with prejudice.

Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(a)(1)(A) provides:

[T]he plaintiff may dismiss an action without a court order by filing:
(i) a notice of dismissal before the opposing party serves either an
answer to a motion for summary judgment; or (ii) a stipulation of
dismissal signed by all parties who have appeared.

Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(a)(1)(A). Because the parties filed a stipulation of dismissal by all parties who
have appeared, this case has terminated.
