

1 (E.D. Cal. June 17, 2010) (denying request to proceed IFP where applicant “failed to adequately
2 document her financial status”).

3 Plaintiff’s application to proceed IFP is incomplete. Although Plaintiff replied in the
4 affirmative when asked whether he owned any “real estate, stocks, bonds, securities, other
5 financial instruments, automobiles or any other thing of value,” he declined to respond to the
6 request on the application that he “describe the property and state its value.” (ECF No. 3).
7 Accordingly, no later than April 24, 2015, Plaintiff must fully complete the application with the
8 required information. Plaintiff is advised that failure to comply with the Court’s order may result
9 in the denial of his application.
