The scheduling order 19 ordered Plaintiff to serve the summons and complaint in this action within twenty days of filing 20 the complaint and to file a return of service with the Court. Accordingly, within ten (10) days from the date of service of this order, Plaintiff shall either file the return of service or inform the Court in writing as to the status of service in this action. Failure to comply with this order will result in this action being dismissed for failure to prosecute.
