ORDER ADOPTING FINDINGS AND
RECOMMENDATIONS AND DENYING
MOTION FOR PRELIMINARY
INJUNCTION

(Doc. Nos. 30, 34)

Plaintiff is appearing *pro se* and *in forma pauperis* in this civil rights filed action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. Plaintiff filed a motion seeking a preliminary injunction on December 7, 2016. (Doc. No. 30.)

The matter was referred to a United States Magistrate Judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302. On December 16, 2016, the assigned magistrate judge issued findings and recommendations recommending that the motion for a preliminary injunction be denied. The findings and recommendations were served on the parties and contained notice that objections thereto were to be filed within thirty days. (Doc. No. 34.) Plaintiff timely filed objections on December 29, 2016. (Doc. No. 39.)

In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C), the undersigned has conducted a *de novo* review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the

1 undersigned concludes the findings and recommendation are supported by the record and by
2 proper analysis.


3 Based on the foregoing,

4 1. The findings and recommendations issued on December 16, 2016 (Doc. No. 34) are
5 adopted in full; and

6 2. Plaintiff's motion for a preliminary injunction filed December 7, 2016 (Doc. No. is
7 denied.
