17 Reamel Curtis ("Plaintiff") is a state prisoner proceeding *pro se* and *in forma pauperis*  
18 with this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. The matter was referred to a United  
19 States magistrate judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302.

20 On March 27, 2018, Magistrate Judge Erica P. Grosjean entered findings and  
21 recommendations, recommending that Plaintiff's motion for leave to file a Second Amended  
22 Complaint (ECF No. 56) be denied. (ECF No. 63.) Plaintiff was given an opportunity to  
23 object to the findings and recommendations. Plaintiff filed his objections on April 23, 2018.  
24 (ECF No. 65.)

25 In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 304, this  
26 Court has conducted a de novo review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file,  
27 the Court finds the findings and recommendations to be supported by the record and proper  
28 analysis.
