**ORDER DIRECTING THE CLERK OF
THE COURT TO CLOSE CASE**

(ECF No. 109)

On July 17, 2018, the parties filed a stipulation to dismiss this action, including Praetorian Insurance Company’s claims and Western Milling LLC’s counter-claim, with prejudice. (ECF No. 109). All parties have agreed to the dismissal. *Id.* In light of the stipulation, the case has ended and is dismissed with prejudice. *See* Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(a)(1)(A); *Wilson v. City of San Jose*, 111 F.3d 688, 692 (9th Cir. 1997); *Concha v. London*, 62 F.3d 1493, 1506 (9th Cir. 1995) (“Even if the defendant has filed a motion to dismiss, the plaintiff may terminate his action voluntarily by filing a notice of dismissal under Rule 41(a)(1).”). Accordingly, the Clerk of the Court is DIRECTED to close this case.
