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20 On July 8, 2015, Plaintiff filed a notice of voluntary dismissal with prejudice pursuant
21 to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(a)(1)(A)(i).

22 In relevant part, Rule 41(a)(1)(A) provides as follows:

23 [A] plaintiff may dismiss an action with a court order by filing: (i) a notice of
24 dismissal before the opposing party serves either an answer or a motion for
25 summary judgment; or (ii) a stipulation of dismissal signed by all parties who
have appeared.

26 Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(a)(1)(A). "The plaintiff may dismiss some or all of the defendants, or some
27 or all of his claims, through a Rule 41(a)(1) notice," and the dismissal "automatically
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1 terminates the action as to the defendants who are the subjects of the notice." *Wilson v. City of*
2 *San Jose*, 111 F.3d 688, 692 (9th Cir. 1997).

3 Because Plaintiff filed a notice of dismissal of this case without prejudice as to all
4 defendants under Rule 41(a)(1)(A)(i), this case has automatically terminated. Fed. R. Civ. P.
5 41(a)(1)(A)(i).

6 Accordingly IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court is to close this
7 case.
