(Doc. 1.) Plaintiff filed a motion to proceed in forma pauperis 19 with his complaint on April 20, 2015. (Doc. 2.) 20 The Court may authorize the commencement of an action without prepayment of fees "but a 21 person who submits an affidavit that includes a statement of all assets such person . . . possesses [and] 22 that the person is unable to pay such fees or give security therefor." 28 U.S.C. § 1915(a). The Court 23 has reviewed the application and the information provided is insufficient to determine whether 24 Plaintiff satisfies the requirements of 28 U.S.C. § 1915(a). 25 According to his application, Plaintiff is not employed, and has\$10 in savings. (Doc. 2 at 1-2.) Further, Plaintiff notes he does not have any income and does not possess real estate, stocks, bonds, 26

securities, other financial instruments, an automobile, or other things of value. *Id.* Consequently, the

Court is unable to determine how Plaintiff is supporting himself or if he is dependent upon another

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individual who would be able to pay the filing fee.

Accordingly, Plaintiff is **ORDERED** to file, within fourteen days of this order, an application that includes information on how Plaintiff is supporting himself, or his dependence on another. Upon receipt of this information, the Court will resume consideration of Plaintiff's motion to proceed in forma pauperis. Plaintiff is warned that failure to comply with this order may result in denial of his application to proceed in forma pauperis.
