On July 6, 2015, Plaintiff consented to the 18 jurisdiction of a Magistrate Judge. (ECF No. 19.) 19 On October 16, 2015, upon Plaintiff's motion, the Court vacated its order dismissing this 20 action, ordered re-service of its August 3, 2015 screening order, and denied his request for the 21 appointment of counsel. (ECF No. 23.) 22 On October 21, 2015, Plaintiff re-filed a motion requesting the same relief that the Court 23 partially granted in its October 16, 2015 order. (ECF No. 24.) It appears the Court's order and 24 Plaintiff's motion crossed in the mail. To the extent that the relief Plaintiff is re-requesting was 25 already granted by the Court's prior order, his motion is denied as moot. His request for the 26 appointment of counsel is denied without prejudice for the reasons explained in the October 21,

2015 order.
