16	Defendant filed a motion to dismiss Plaintiff's first amended complaint on July 24, 2015. (Doc.		
17	27) Plaintiff contends the motion should be stricken for failure to comply with Local Rule 131, which		
18	requires that all electronic filings be signed. (Doc. 28) According to Plaintiff, Defendant violated the		
19	Local Rules because there is "the Motion to Dismiss has no original signature," and no proof of service		
20	was filed. (Id. at 2)		
21	Significantly, however, Defendant filed a proof of service indicating the motion to dismiss was		
22	served on Plaintiff by mail on July 23, 2015. (Doc. 27-1 at 1) Both the proof of service and the motion		
23	to dismiss bear electronic signatures. (See id; Doc. 27 at 5) Pursuant to Local Rule 131, electronic		
24	signatures are permitted when filing documents with the Court:		
25	Anything filed using an attorney's name, login, and password will be deemed to have been signed by that attorney for all purposes including Fed. P. Civ. P. 11. For example		
26	been signed by that attorney for all purposes, including Fed. R. Civ. P. 11. For example, for the attorney whose login and password is being used, it is sufficient to indicate a signature as in the following example: "/s/ John M. Barrister, Esquire."
