

1 been diligently preparing a motion for summary judgment, which is complex and requires several
2 declarations in support of the motion. Additional time is needed to finalize the declarations, and some
3 delays are anticipated in reviewing, executing, and receiving executed declarations due to the
4 upcoming holidays.

5 Plaintiff has not yet responded to the motion to modify the discovery and scheduling order, but
6 the Court finds no response is necessary. Local Rule 230(1). Plaintiff will not be prejudiced by the
7 brief extension of time here, which shall be equally applied to both parties.

8 Good cause being shown, Defendants' motion to modify the discovery and scheduling order is
9 HEREBY GRANTED. The deadline for filing all dispositive motions (other than a motion for
10 summary judgment for failure to exhaust) is extended to **January 5, 2018**.
