On May 28, 2015, Plaintiff Rosalinda Coronado (“Plaintiff”) filed an application to proceed in forma pauperis. (ECF No. 3.) On June 9, 2015, the Court ordered Plaintiff to either file a long form application to proceed in forma pauperis or to pay the filing fee because the original application indicated that Plaintiff possessed sufficient income to pay the filing fee.
