21 Brian C. Applegate (“Plaintiff”) is a state prisoner proceeding pro se and in forma
22 pauperis in this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. On May 29, 2015, Plaintiff
23 filed the Complaint commencing this action. (ECF No. 1.) The case now proceeds with the
24 initial Complaint, against Defendant Christian Trausch (“Defendant”), on Plaintiff’s Eighth
25 Amendment claim and related state law claims.

26 On May 19, 2017, the court issued an order lifting the stay of proceedings for this case
27 and requiring Plaintiff to show cause why this case should not be dismissed. (ECF No. 41.)
28 On June 7, 2017, Plaintiff filed a response showing cause why this case should not be
dismissed. (ECF No. 42.) Therefore, the order to show cause shall be discharged.
