Doc. 9 at 14 1. Because Defendant had already answered, Doc. 5, the Court will construe Plaintiff's filing as a notice 15 of voluntary dismissal brought under Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(a)(2), which permits the Court to dismiss an 16 action on a plaintiff's request "on terms that the court considers proper." Here, Defendant has had ample 17 time to object to dismissal and has not done so. Accordingly, the Court concludes that dismissal with 18 prejudice is appropriate.
