The action proceeds against 21 Defendant Musleh on Plaintiff's Eighth Amendment failure to protect claim. 22 On July 6, 2015, Plaintiff consented to have a United States Magistrate Judge 23 conduct all further proceedings in this case, including trial and entry of final judgment, 24 pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(c)(1). (ECF No. 6.) On May 13, 2016, after the Court 25 screened Plaintiff's first amended complaint and dismissed several claims and

defendants, Plaintiff filed a request to withdraw his consent to Magistrate Judge

jurisdiction. (ECF No. 10.) The undersigned denied the motion on the ground that

Plaintiff failed to present good cause or extraordinary circumstances to support his request. <u>Dixon v. Ylst</u>, 990 F.2d 478, 479 (9th Cir. 2003); <u>see also</u> 28 U.S.C. § 636(c)(4). (ECF No. 14.)

On May 31, 2016, Plaintiff filed objections to the order denying his request to withdraw his consent to Magistrate Judge jurisdiction. (ECF No. 15.) The matter was assigned to a District Judge and the undersigned issued findings and recommendations to deny Plaintiff's request.

Following the issuance of the findings and recommendations, Defendant Musleh appeared in the action and declined Magistrate Judge jurisdiction. In light of Defendant Musleh's declination, this matter will remain assigned to the undersigned and District Judge Dale A. Drozd.

Based on the foregoing, Plaintiff's objections are moot and are HEREBY DENIED without prejudice. For the same reason, the findings and recommendations are HEREBY VACATED.
