

1 (E.D. Cal. June 17, 2010) (denying request to proceed IFP where applicant “failed to adequately
2 document her financial status”). Similarly, all “[a]ffidavits and certifications shall be signed by
3 the person executing the document.” Local Rule 131(b).

4 Plaintiff’s application to proceed *in forma pauperis* is incomplete and unclear. Although
5 Plaintiff states that he has no gross pay or wages and has not received any income in the past 12
6 months, he attaches what appears to be paycheck from the Tulare County School District that was
7 issued on April 15, 2015. He also lists items “of value that I own,” but declined to respond to the
8 request on the application that he “describe the property and its approximate value.” (ECF No. 3).
9 He has also listed two “regular monthly expenses,” but declines to “describe and provide the
10 amount of the monthly expense.” *Id.* Finally, the application is unsigned.

11 Accordingly, no later than **July 8, 2015**, Plaintiff must fully and accurately complete the
12 application with the required information. Plaintiff is advised that failure to comply with the
13 Court’s order may result in the denial of his application or dismissal of his case.
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17 IT IS SO ORDERED.
