17	Plaintiff Rupert Flowers ("Plaintiff") is a California state prisoner proceeding pro se in this	
18	civil action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. Plaintiff filed this action on June 16, 2015.	
19	On June 25, 2015, Plaintiff filed a notice of voluntary dismissal pursuant to Federal Rule of	
20	Civil Procedure 41(a)(1)(i). At this stage in the proceedings, Plaintiff has the absolute right to	
21	dismiss his claims, without prejudice. <u>Duke Energy Trading and Marketing, L.L.C. v. Davis</u> , 267	
22	F.3d 1042, 1049 (9th Cir. 2001). The filing of the notice itself has the effect of closing the action,	
23	and the Court no longer has jurisdiction over the claims. <u>Id</u> .
