The matter was referred to a United States 19 20 Magistrate Judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302. 21 On January 23, 2019, the assigned magistrate judge issued findings and recommendations, 22 recommending that plaintiff's motion for injunctive relief be denied because the court lacks jurisdiction over individuals who are not parties to this action. (Doc. No. 99 at 2.) The findings 23 24 and recommendations were served on plaintiff and contained notice that any objections were to

be filed within twenty-one days after service. (Id.) To date, no objections to the findings and recommendations have been filed, and the time in which to do so has now passed.
