Stress Disorder ("PTSD") while in the custody of the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation ("CDCR"). Plaintiff claims that at multiple institutions and over several years, his PTSD was not properly considered by prison officials in determining his housing status. On December 15, 2020, the Court issued an order extending the deadline for the completion of all discovery, including filing all motions to compel discovery, to June 11, 2021. (ECF No. 154.) Currently before the Court is Plaintiff's motion to modify the discovery and scheduling order, dated June 11, 2021 and filed with the Court June 17, 2021. (ECF No. 165.) In his motion, Plaintiff requests that the Court extend the current deadline for the filing of any motions to compel up to and including August 11, 2021. (*Id.*) Defendants have not filed a response. The Court finds it appropriate to obtain a response from Defendants regarding the motion. Accordingly, Defendants shall file a response to Plaintiff's motion within **fourteen (14) days** from the date of service of this order. Plaintiff's reply, if any, is due within seven (7) days from the date of service of Defendants' response. IT IS SO ORDERED. /s/Barbara A. McAuliffe Dated: **July 12, 2021**
