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18	Plaintiff Jared M. Villery is a state prisoner proceeding pro se and in forma pauperis in		
19	this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. This matter was referred to a United States		
20	Magistrate Judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302.		
21	On July 5, 2017, the assigned magistrate judge screened plaintiff's first amended		
22	complaint (Doc. No. 22) and issued findings and recommendations recommending that this action		
23	proceed against defendants Kendall, Acosta, Naficy, Jones, Guerrero, Aithal, Seymour,		
24	Carrizales, Woodard, Pallares, Hernandez, Fisher, Grimmig, and Miranda for deliberate		
25	indifference in violation of the Eighth Amendment, and against defendants Beard and Kernan for		
26	promulgation of a policy to deny single cell housing for inmates with serious mental disorders in		
27	violation of the Eighth Amendment. (Doc. No. 25.) The magistrate judge further recommended		
28	that plaintiff's claims against defendants CDCR, J. Lewis, R. L. Briggs, K. Z. Allen, Oleg		
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1	Liflyandsky, C. Cornell, Barbara Zager, Kimberly Holland, R. A. Groves, and C. Schuyler be	
2	dismissed for the failure to state a claim upon which relief may be granted. (Id.)	
3	The findings and recommendations were served on plaintiff and contained notice that any	
4	objections thereto were to be filed within thirty (30) days after service. More than thirty days	
5	have passed, and no objections have been filed.	
6	In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C), this court has conducted a	
7	de novo review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the court finds the findings	
8	and recommendations to be supported by the record and by proper analysis.	
9	Accordingly,	
10	1. The findings and recommendations issued on July 5, 2017 (Doc. No. 25) are	
11	adopted in full;	
12	2. This action shall proceed against defendants Kendall, Acosta, Naficy, Jones,	
13	Guerrero, Aithal, Seymour, Carrizales, Woodard, Pallares, Hernandez, Fisher, Grimmig, and	
14	Miranda for deliberate indifference in violation of the Eighth Amendment, and against defendants	
15	5 Beard and Kernan for promulgation of a policy to deny single cell housing for inmates with	
16	6 serious mental disorders, in violation of the Eighth Amendment;	
17	3. Plaintiff's claims against defendants CDCR, J. Lewis, R. L. Briggs, K. Z. Allen,	
18	Oleg Liflyandsky, C. Cornell, Barbara Zager, Kimberly Holland, R. A. Groves, and C. Schuyler	
19	are dismissed from this action for the failure to state a claim upon which relief may be granted;	
20	and	
21	4. This action is referred back to the magistrate judge for further proceedings	
22	consistent with this order.
