20	order. (ECF No. 112). While titled as objections to Defendants' motion for a protective order,

23	disclosures.	
24	Plaintiff's motion will be denied because has presented no evidence that Defendants	
25	lied to the Court. However, because Plaintiff has alleged that he did not receive Defendants'	
26	initial disclosures, the Court will order Defendants to serve Plaintiff with a copy of their initial
