19	Plaintiff Manuel Antonio Gonzalez III is a state prisoner proceeding pro se in this civil			
20		1983. With his complaint plaintiff filed a motion		
21	for a temporary restraining order and/or preliminary injunction seeking an order prohibiting			
22	certain prison staff members from coming wi	thin two-hundred feet of him. Plaintiff also moved		
23	for the appointment of an investigator to meet with him every thirty days during the pendency of			
24	this action. On December 29, 2015, findings and recommendations were entered, recommending			
25	that plaintiff's motion for temporary restraining order and/or preliminary injunction, as well as his			
26	motion for appointment of an investigator, be denied. (Doc. No. 23.) Plaintiff was provided an			
27	opportunity to file objections to the findings and recommendations within thirty days. No			
28	objections to the findings and recommendations were filed.

In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 304, the
 undersigned has conducted a de novo review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire
 file, the court adopts the recommendation that plaintiff's motions be denied.

4 Plaintiff requests a temporary restraining order or preliminary injunctive relief to be 5 issued against all defendants because in June 2015, prior to the filing of the instant lawsuit, one of 6 the named defendants (defendant Brennan) allegedly threatened him with harm for pursuing this 7 litigation. (Doc. No. 3, at 6.) "A plaintiff seeking a preliminary injunction must establish that he 8 is likely to succeed on the merits, that he is likely to suffer irreparable harm in the absence of 9 preliminary relief, that the balance of equities tips in his favor, and that an injunction is in the public interest." Winter v. Natural Resources Defense Council, Inc., 555 U.S. 7, 20 (2008). A 10 preliminary injunction is an "extraordinary remedy never awarded as of right." Winter, 555 U.S. 11 12 at 24. Here, even assuming the court could grant the preliminary relief sought, plaintiff has not 13 made a sufficient showing of the likelihood of irreparable harm or of the likelihood of success on the merits to warrant the granting of preliminary relief.¹ Therefore, the court adopts the 14 recommendation that plaintiff's motion for a temporary restraining order or a preliminary 15 16 objection be denied.

The undersigned also adopts the analysis and conclusion set forth in the findings and
recommendations concerning plaintiff's request to be appointed an investigator. Accordingly,
plaintiff's motion for appointment of an expert will be denied.

20 For the reasons set forth above:

21 22 The court adopts the recommendation of the findings and recommendations (Doc. No. 23), as discussed above; and

¹ The analysis in the findings and recommendations which focused on plaintiff's purported lack
 of standing to seek injunctive relief generally in this case is not adopted. Since plaintiff has not sought general injunctive relief for the harm alleged in his underlying complaint, the undersigned
 finds it unnecessary to address plaintiff's standing to seek such relief.

1	2. Plaintiff's motion for temporary restraining order and/or preliminary injunction to be		
2	appointed an investigator (Doc. No. 3) is DENIED.
