18	Plaintiff Manuel Gonzalez is a state prisoner proceeding this civil rights action filed	
19	pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983, and which also includes state law claims. The matter was referred	
20	to a United States Magistrate Judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302.	
21	On January 3, 2017, plaintiff filed what the assigned magistrate judge construed as a	
22	motion for a preliminary injunction. (Doc. No. 34.) Therein, plaintiff asked the court to	
23	intervene in his pending prison transfer. (Id.) On February 22, 2017, the magistrate judge	
24	entered findings and recommendations, recommending that plaintiff's motion for a preliminary	
25	injunction be denied as moot because plaintiff had by then been transferred to the prison he had	
26	requested in his motion. (Doc No. 42.) Plaintiff was provided an opportunity to file objections to	
27	the findings and recommendations within twenty-one days. (Id.) No objections were filed.
