2	Based on the above stipulation, the Court GRANTS Defendant an extension of time to		
2	respond to Plaintiff's Opening Brief. Defendant's Opposition Brief shall be filed no later than		
4	December 13, 2016 . Any reply by Plaintiff may be filed no later than December 28, 2016 .		
5	The Court has further reviewed Defendant's response to its Order to Show Cause. (ECF		
6	No. 24.) While the Court understands that counsel may be responsible for a large number of		
7	cases, the management of deadlines within those cases is counsel's responsibility. The Court is		
8	willing to grant requests for extension of time liberally, but a complete failure to comply with a
