HOLLAND, et al., 14 Defendants. 15 On April 27, 2017, Defendants filed a motion for summary judgment under Federal Rule 16 of Civil Procedure 56, arguing that Plaintiff failed to exhaust his administrative remedies prior to 17 filing this case. (ECF No. 37). On May 15, 2017, Plaintiff filed his opposition to the motion. 18 (ECF No. 41). On May 22, 2017, Defendants filed their reply and objections to Plaintiff's 19 evidence. (ECF Nos. 43 & 44). After reviewing the evidence, the Court has determined that 20 there is a dispute of material fact and that an Albino evidentiary hearing is necessary. See Albino 21 v. Baca, 747 F.3d 1162, 1170 (9th Cir. 2014). Accordingly, the Court will set a conference 22 23 regarding the setting of an evidentiary hearing. The parties should also be prepared to discuss the 24 procedures and scope of the evidentiary hearing. In accordance with the above, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that: 25 1. A conference regarding the setting of an evidentiary hearing is set before Magistrate 26 Judge Erica P. Grosjean on May 31, 2017, at 11:00 a.m. at the Robert E. Coyle 27
