Petitioner indicates that he is being assisted by 22 another inmate in this matter due to his lack of knowledge of the law and his limited English 23 abilities. Petitioner argues that in order to adequately respond to the fifty-page answer filed by 24 Respondent, he needs to be afforded the opportunity to strengthen and further develop the 25 arguments set forth in the traverse. 26 // 27
