COUNSEL TO INFORM THE COURT
WHETHER A WRIT OF HABEAS CORPUS
AD TESTIFICANDUM IS NECESSARY TO
SECURE PLAINTIFF'S ATTENDANCE AT
TRIAL

SEVEN-DAY DEADLINE

Plaintiff Elaine K. Villareal is proceeding *in forma pauperis* in this civil rights action brought pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. Based on the record in this case, it is unclear if Plaintiff Elaine Villareal is currently incarcerated. Thus, it is unclear if the Court must issue a writ of habeas corpus ad testificandum to secure Plaintiff's attendance at the trial, which is currently set for November 8, 2022.

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that Plaintiff's counsel has seven days from the date of service of this order to file a notice informing the Court whether a writ of habeas corpus ad testificandum is necessary to secure Plaintiff's attendance at the trial.
