(Doc. 1) On September 29, 2015, the Court issued Findings 20 and Recommendations to summarily dismiss the petition as frivolous. (Doc. 5). On November 19, 21 2015, the District Judge assigned to the case adopted those Findings and Recommendations and 22 dismissed the petition and entered judgment. (Docs. 8; 9) On November 30, 2015, Petitioner filed the 23 instant motions requesting appointment of counsel and expediting of the resolution of his claims. 24 (Docs. 10; 12)
