16	in this civil rights action filed pursuant to	42 U.S.C. § 1983. The matter proceeds against
17	Defendant Kandkhorova on Plaintiff's Eighth Amendment claim for inadequate medical	
18	care.	
19	On February 16, 2017, the parties filed a stipulation and request to stay the case.	
20	(ECF No. 27.) The request is based on a recent adjudication by the Tehama County	
21	Superior Court finding Plaintiff incompetent to stand trial in an unrelated criminal action.	
22	They request a six month stay, following which the parties agree to meet and confer	
23	regarding Plaintiff's competency status.	
24	While the Court agrees that Pla	intiff's competency status warrants a stay, the
25	Court must maintain control of its docke	et and ensure that cases do not sit idly without
26	reason. Accordingly, the Court will stay	the matter for 120 days, and will require the
27	parties to submit a joint status report regarding Plaintiff's competency status ninety days	
28	from the date of this order.
