

1 conducted the in camera review of two investigations (in redacted form) of two claims of a sexual
2 nature made by juvenile wards against probation officers while the wards were in custody. The court
3 finds both investigations should be produced. The Court makes no comment or finding about the
4 admissibility of these documents at trial. Thus, the Court **ORDERS:**

5 1. **Within three court days**, copies of the records (with Bates numbers added) of the two
6 investigations¹ **SHALL** be produced to counsel for the plaintiffs in both cases captioned above

7 2. **No later than August 16, 2016**, the defendants **SHALL** retrieve the documents that
8 were subject to the in camera review, from the Clerk of the Court, at the United States Courthouse
9 located at 510 19th Street, Suite 200, Bakersfield, CA.
