16	rights action brought pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. The action was dismissed with	
17	prejudice for failure to state a claim, and Plaintiff appealed. (ECF Nos. 38 & 42.) Before	
18	the Court are Plaintiff's February 21, 2017 "Motion to Add Jurisdiction" and "Motion to	
19	Add Jurisdiction [and for a] Preliminary Injunction." (ECF No. 40 & 41.)	
20	As Plaintiff's case is now closed, the desired relief is not available. <u>See Zepeda v</u>	
21	United States Immigration Serv., 753 F.2d 719, 727 (9th Cir. 1985) (the Court lacks	
22	jurisdiction to direct the actions of parties not before the Court).	
23	Accordingly, Plaintiff's motions are HEREBY DENIED.
