1	California for re-issuance with a more current date. The checks should include the same witness
2	information and fee amounts, but need to be re-issued and sent to the Court with a current date.
3	To avoid another continuation of the trial date in this matter, the Court requests that these
4	checks be re-issued as soon as practicable.
5	Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:
6	1. The Clerk of the Court is DIRECTED to return the following checks to the State of
7	California (California State Prison – Los Angeles County) for re-issuance by the State of
8	California as soon as practicable:
9	a. One State of California Check #198-1173595 in the amount of \$160.96 for witness
10	Malvin U. Pallomina, NP, submitted by Plaintiff on December 27, 2021;
11	b. One State of California Check #198-1173596 in the amount of \$130.72 for witness
12	M. Becina, RN, submitted by Plaintiff on December 27, 2021;
13	2. In the interest of expediting this matter, the Clerk of the Court is also DIRECTED, using
14	the Court's CM/ECF system, to serve courtesy copies of this order on:
15	a. Monica Anderson, Senior Assistant Attorney General; and
16	b. Lawrence Bragg, Supervising Deputy Attorney General.
