19	1. This is a civil in rem proceeding	seeking the forfeiture of the above-captioned property	
20	pursuant to 21 U.S.C. § 881(a)(6).		
21	2. On March 11, 2016, the United S	States filed a motion for default (the "Default Motion")	
22	against Juan Plazola and Eduardo Maya. (ECF #9.)		
23	3. On April 26, 2016, the Magistrat	e Judge issued Findings and Recommendations granting	
24	the United States' Default Motion (ECF #12.)		
25	4. On May 26, 2016, the District Co	ourt Judge granted, in part, the United States' Default	
26	Motion. (ECF #13.) The Court ordered that the	e United States identify, locate, and provide direct service	
27	to the registered owner of the vehicle in which the defendant currency was located, who was identified in		
28	the Complaint only as "Marcia" (identified by the	ne United States as Marcia Salcido).	

1	5.	On June 9, 2016, the Court granted the United States an additional 60 days to effectuate
2	service on M	s. Salcido. (ECF #15.)
3	6.	On October 3, 2016, the United States filed a Status Report outlining its efforts to notice
4	Ms. Salcido,	including asking the United States Marshals Service to attempt personal service on Marcia
5	Salcido. The	United States' status report indicated that it would in the near future be renewing its motion
6	for default ju	dgment.
7		Status Report
8	7.	On November 26, 2016, the United States identified a second potential address for Salcido.
9	Even though	the United States Marshals Service served Marcia Salcido's daughter, who indicated that
10	Marcia Salci	do was in Mexico, the United States plans to send notice to the new address discovered for
11	Marcia Salcido.	
12	8.	On December 8, 2016 and December 9, 2016, the United States also placed calls to the cell
13	phone number	er for Marcia Salcido. The cell phone number indicated that "the person you are calling
14	cannot be acc	cepted at this time. We are sorry for any convenience this may cause." The United States
15	would like to	attempt to contact Marcia Salcido by telephone again after a week or so has passed.
16	9.	By rule, once notice has been sent, Marcia Salcido will have 35 days to file a claim.
17	10.	Thus, the United States requests an additional 60 days (or until February 9, 2017) to
18	finalize its efforts to notice Ms. Salcido, allow statutory deadlines to run, and then renew its motion for	
19	default judgr	nent.
